DON'T BECOME LAZY AND SNORE

The Devil is a piece of work.

The plotting, scheming, mind-changing and interjecting ... it can be frustrating and overwhelming.

What about this... the Devil's doings sharpen our focus, keep us moving forward and striving for excellence?

Could the Devil's work be a good thing?

Martin Luther shares: When the Devil introduces perverse thoughts into our heads against our will and in spite of our struggle against them, God wishes to occupy us so that we don't get lazy and snore but fight against them and pray.

How do we respond?

On March 27, 2024, Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds signed into law new minimum salaries for public school teachers.

The legislation, which becomes effective July 1, 2024, states: The salaries for new teachers must be at least \$47,500, and the salaries for teachers with at least 12 years of experience must be at least \$60,000.

For Christian schools, already struggling to support faculty and staffs financially, the plotting, scheming and interjecting creates frustration.

How do we respond? How do we keep up? How do we sharpen our focus? How do we push forward?

How do we strive for excellence, supporting and caring for our staff, while providing excellent teaching to our students?

Details will be shared during a June 9 congregational forum, which will include an overview of Trinity's plan for ministry.
