JESUS IN OUR DIET

Families need Jesus in their diet.

The temptations and cravings are too overwhelming.

The consumption of false teachings has created unhealthy habits and brokenness in families.

The devil rejoices – destruction of the family destroys God's precious creation to pass on a godly legacy. Families have been under attack and fragmented since the fall of Adam.

"Family is the Lord's institution first for life among His people, and then as a foundation for society," shared Pastor Timothy Pauls, who will be presenting – at Trinity Lutheran on Aug. 10 - on the importance of nurturing family in a Christian home.

Pastor Pauls, who serves at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Boise, Idaho, adds: The Lord first creates family when He creates Adam and Eve, blessing them with the ability to be fruitful and multiply. Within that family is where people are not alone, where parents will instruct their children in the ways of the Lord, and where children honor their parents – the authority of society. The wonder of Genesis 2 is that the biological family and the Church are the same.

The challenges and cravings are still present.

"Because of Adam's fall, however, the family fragments," shared Pastor Pauls. "Cain's murder of Abel and subsequent departure east of Eden divides the first family – not only geographically, but now between believer and unbelievers. This fragmentation continues to attack family, society and the Church."

Families need Jesus in their diet – through His body, blood and word.
