In Luke 1:38, Mary tells the angel: I am the Lord's servant. May your word to me be fulfilled.

Mary's response is packed with obedience, trust, and humility.

One scribe suggests that Luke compares Mary's actions as a model for Christian discipleship.

It's the mindset of giving away to receive – think what Mary gave in order to receive.
