CALL COMMITTEE SEEKS NAMES

For the first time in 17 years, Trinity Lutheran is seeking a new principal.

Bill Meyer announced on January 10 that he would be retiring from full-time Lutheran education at the end of the school year.

The initial steps of finding Mr. Meyer's replacement are underway.

A Call Committee has been formed and includes: Mark Jorgensen (chair of the committee), Lisa Lindholm, James Ullman, Kelsey Pearson, Matt Knutsen, Kim Mester, Eric Schocker, Rich Goodwin, Deje Jensen, Pastor Schilling and Pastor Golter.

The committee, which had its initial meeting on Jan. 30, is seeking names of candidates to be considered – the deadline to submit a name is Feb. 16.

Based on survey responses from church and school families, the committee's key characteristics they value most when seeking principal candidates are: spiritual leadership, education leadership, communication, collaboration, administration, and leadership.

In addition to filling its principal position, Trinity is seeking teaching candidates for fourth and fifth grade, along with middle school history for the 2025-26 school year.

A Call Committee has been formed to seek potential teaching candidates.
