TIMING IS RIGHT FOR TLS PRINCIPAL

For Bill Meyer, it was a gut feeling.

"I just thought it was the right time," shared Mr. Meyer, who announced on Jan. 10 that he would be retiring from full-time Lutheran education at the end of this school year. "Trinity is in a good position for a new leader to take over."

Mr. Meyer has been in Lutheran education for 44 years, with the past 17 years being spent serving as Trinity's principal.

"Trinity always has had a great reputation throughout the community and beyond, and that's because of the great staff we have. It sure has helped make the job easier."

So, what's the plan for retirement?

"I'm planning to work with schools that are just getting started, mentoring them through the process," Mr. Meyer shared. "Beyond that, we'll see what the Lord has in mind."

In addition of needing to fill its principal vacancy for the 2025-26 school year, Trinity is seeking teaching candidates for fourth and fifth grade, along with a middle school history teacher.

Call committees have been formed, and the process of finding candidates is underway.

Trinity is excited to share that Lori Ralfs, who taught fourth grade at Trinity this past year, has accepted the school's open librarian position.

"Trinity has been around for 155 years, preaching and teaching the Gospel, and that will always continue," Mr. Meyer shared.
