Trinity's gym floor is a safety issue - it has lost its traction – and so are the bleachers, which have been pushed and pulled for the past 25-plus years.

A gym floor and bleacher fix is being formulated, along with other potential gym improvements.

It's another step moving forward.

Moving forward with faith and the gift of gratitude.

"Gratitude toward our Maker, the Giver of all we are and have, is the hug that the child of God gives the Creator and Re-creator of our lives," shared Rev. Dr. Robert Kolb, who is a professor emeritus of Systematic Theology at Concordia Seminary in St. Louis.
