# SHARING THE SAME MESSAGE

Members of Trinity's High School Youth Group will be joining forces with more than 20,000 other teens from around the world this summer.

They all will be proclaiming the same message: Jesus is our creator and savior.

Trinity is sending 31 high schoolers and six adults to the LCMS Youth Gathering in New Orleans on July 19-23.

"This will be a life-changing experience for these students," shared Kari Smith, who leads Trinity's High School Youth Group. "We will spend the week growing in our faith, serving, singing and praying."

Since 1980, the LCMS Youth Gathering has been held every three years. The gathering provides high schoolers the opportunity to come together as a community of God's people to be encouraged in their walk with Jesus.

"The preparation for this trip is a long process," Kari Smith shared. "It takes a lot of work to make it possible."

Trinity's Youth Group needs your support.

"We need prayer that our group grows in unity," Kari Smith shared. "We need prayer for safe travels, and that the Holy Spirit uses this trip to impact us all in a powerful way."

The group also is in need of donations.

So far, the group has raised \$25,000 to help offset costs for the trip – but still is in need of about \$15,000 more to cover the entire cost.
